Subject: Ordinance 3385 - Ban on Psilocybin - Third Reading

Report

At the July 26th, 2022 Regular Council Meeting, City Council instructed staff to have ordinance 3385 prepared for introduction and reading for the first time. City Council voted to do a second reading by title only of the ordinance the same meeting. The Ordinance is prepared for City Council to complete the third reading. It is then eligible for a vote to place the ordinance en route to final passage. This ordinance will become in effect when a majority of the voters at the November 8th, 2022 election are in support of the ban on Psilocybin.

Ready to be read for a third time in this regular session of city council is Ordinance 3385 AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A BAN ON PSILOCYBIN SERVICE CENTERS AND THE MANUFACTURE OF PSILOCYBIN PRODUCTS. Following the City Charter Chapter VIII, Section 25. Ordinance #3385 is to be read for the third time on August 9, 2022, regular council meeting. According to the Charter the ordinance is to be read without a vote by the Council.

The Ordinance may be read for a third time by title only with a unanimous vote of Council during the meeting.
