COMMENTS & CONSIDERATIONS:

This unit has major corrosion and mechanical issues making it an unreliable unit for the daily tasks required by our Parks division. The unit has bent frame issues from snowplowing and multiple dented body panels. The unit is responsible for pulling a trailer with mowers, as well as personel, around the city to maintain the grounds. This unit has outlived its purpose and requires replacement with an evaluation score of 12.

FLEET MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

Fleet staff recommends replacing this unit with a 2021 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 Double cab pickup. This unit meets the needs of pulling a trailer and offers some extra personel space to get from one area to another without need for additional vehicles. The current unit will be sold via online auction after the new unit has arrived and is placed into service.
