COMMENTS & CONSIDERATIONS:

This unit was used by the Fire Dept before being repurposed with the Sanitation Dept (Transfer Station). The unit has cosmetic defects due to age and has excessive engine hours on it making it unreliable for daily use for the Sanitation Dept needs. The unit, only being a midsize pickup, does not fit the needs of the dept due to lack of load capacity and space. This unit scored 11 on it evaluation making it eligible for replacement.

FLEET MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATIONS:

Fleet staff recommends replacing this unit with a 2021 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 Double Cab Pickup. This new unit has the towing capacity for the new dump trailers being offered by the City and personel space needed for the daily tasks of the division. The current unit will be sold via online auction once the new unit arrives and is placed into service.
