**COMMENTS & CONSIDERATIONS:**

This unit is a supervisor truck for the sanitation dept. The unit is too small for the daily needs of the dept. The unit is starting to show signs of corrosion and has excessive miles on mechanical pieces, causing it to be unreliable for daily use. This unit is 5 years over its replacement and scored a 12 on this evaluation.

**FLEET MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATIONS:**

It is recommended by Fleet staff that this unit be replaced with a 2021 Chevrolet Silverado 2500 4wd Crew cab pickup. This new unit will provide the space needed for everyday supervisor tasks and allow for more passenger space during travel. The old unit will be sold via online auction once the new unit arrives and is placed into service.
