CAP had 10 regulatory compliance inspections in 2022 with zero “notices of violation.”

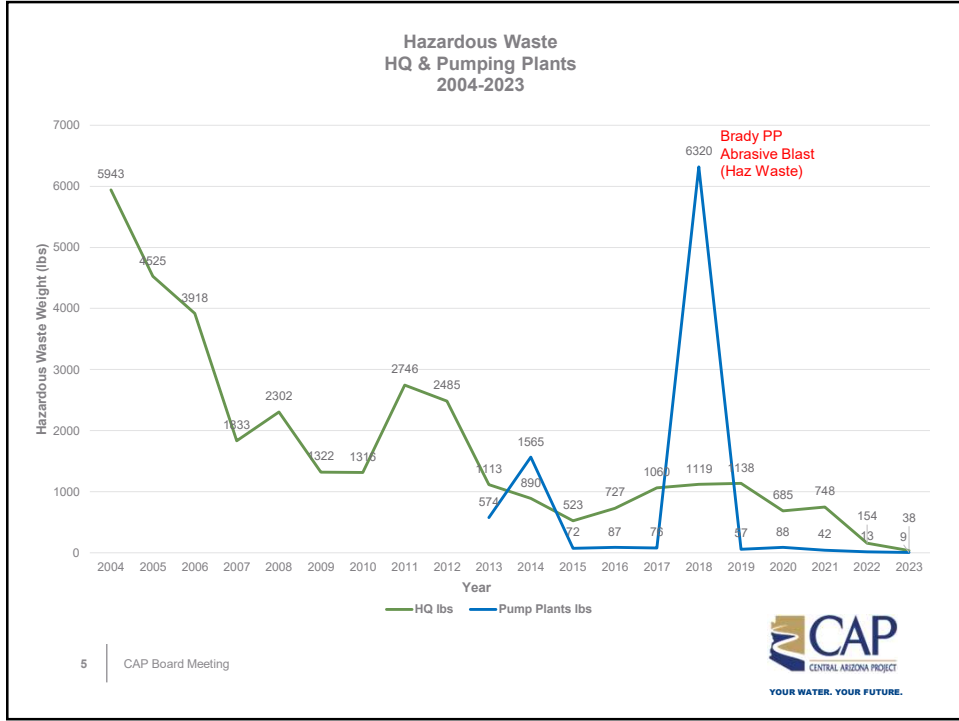
- Conduct quarterly inspections

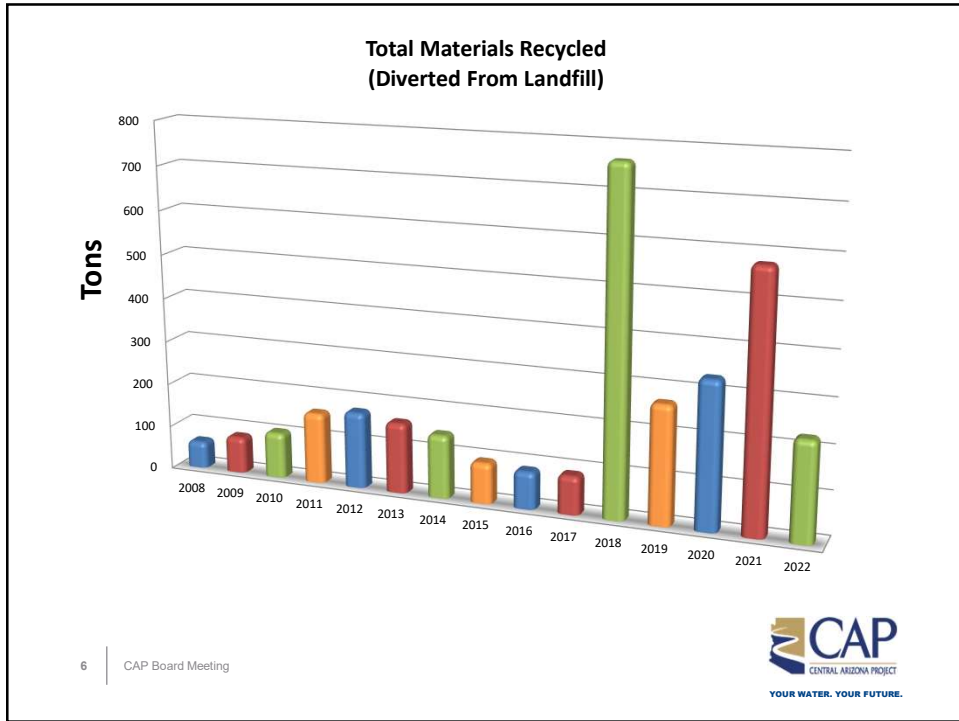

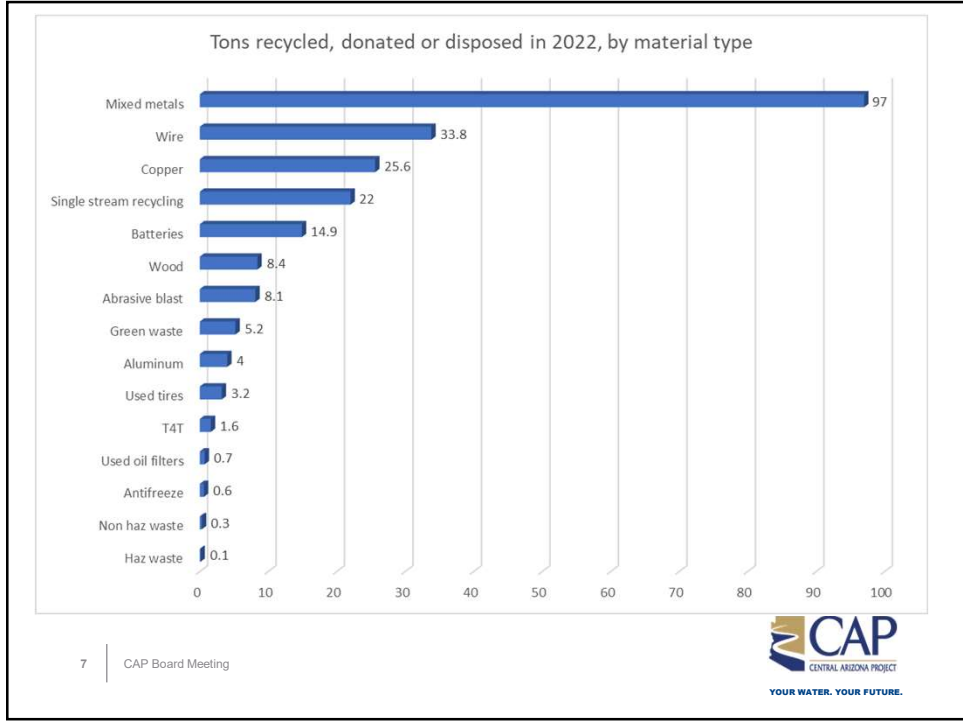
