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### COUNCIL ACTION

1. Public Hearing
2. An Ordinance Vacating Approximately 1.42 Acres of Unimproved Public Right-of-Way Identified as Ann Byrd Court and Harraway Lane.

### SUMMARY

The Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority has requested in writing that the City of Danville vacate approximately 1.42 acres of unimproved right-of-way, currently known as Ann Byrd Court and Harraway Lane, to the Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority. The original creation of these rights-of-way was from an original property owned by Thomas M. Brodnax as shown on a plat by H.S. Peirce dated June 28, 1965. The plat showed the creation of these rights-of-way and several adjacent individual parcels. All of the individual parcels are owned by the Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority. All applicable city departments have reviewed the request and no concerns were indicated. Public notice has been published as required.

### BACKGROUND

As allowed by Section 15.2-2006 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, the City of Danville has a policy in which applicants can request City Council to vacate right-of-way or alleys adjacent to their property. The applicant is responsible for paying the actual cost incurred by the City regarding the public hearing advertisement plus a fee for processing the application.

### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that City Council adopt the accompanying Ordinance vacating approximately 1.42 acres of unimproved right-of-way, currently known as Ann Byrd Court and Harraway Lane, to the Danville Redevelopment and Housing Authority.
