- 31.4 acres of land is approximately 1% of the City's existing canopy coverage
- In 2019, the City's coverage was 39%. Staff estimated at there are approximately 33 trees per acre of land in the 2021 Final Report for Recommendations to increase the City's Canopy (Resolution 2021-123).
- Comp Plan Policy 5.11.03 restricts the City's canopy coverage from falling below 37%.
- We will work with the Property Appraiser and a 3<sup>rd</sup> party contractor to update the City's Canopy coverage analysis in the Fall of 2023.
