Issue a Proclamation that May 15-21, 2022 shall be Public Works Week in Holly Springs.

Explanation:

- National Public Works Week honors the importance of public works services and the men and women who deliver these services.
- This year's theme is "Ready & Resilient" -- Public works professionals are always READY to serve their communities and RESILIENT as ever in their abilities to pick themselves up off the ground after encountering challenges.
- Public works professionals help keep communities strong by providing an infrastructure of services in transportation, water, wastewater and stormwater treatment, public buildings and spaces, parks and grounds, emergency management and first response, solid waste, and right-of-way management. They are what make our communities great places to live and work.
- The Mayor wishes to join with representatives of the American Public Works Association in proclaiming May 15-21, 2022 as Public Works Week in Holly Springs.

Background:

- The American Public Works Association (APWA) established National Public Works Week (NPWW) in 1960.
- The NPWW is used to energize and educate the public of the importance of public works to their daily lives: planning, building, managing and operating at the heart of their local communities to improve the everyday quality of life.
- This proclamation recognizes the important work done by the Public Works, Utilities & Infrastructure and Parks and Recreation Departments.
