12th Street Stabilization Options

RECOMMENDATION

Approve one of three options to repair the bank along 12th Street presented by staff.

SUMMARY

In 2001, at the direction of the Physical Development Committee, Public Works staff stabilized the bank along 12th Street between Jackson Street and Harrison Street. The repair included installation of a wire mesh along a major portion of the face of the bank to prevent erosion from blocking 12th Street and causing a safety issue for the traveling public. During the heavy rains in July 2023, a portion of the bank failed and eroded into 12th Street closing the road to traffic. Since that time, the staff researched three repair options and costs for each option:

- Pinned Mesh- \$2,105,000
- Pinned Mesh with Shotcrete Rough Finish-\$2,455,000
- Pinned Mesh Stained and Sculpted Finish-\$3,290,00

Staff will present funding options at a future City Council meeting once a repair option is approved.
