Conditional Use Permit (CUP) - University of Lynchburg Office Space - 333, 335, & 337 College Street

RECOMMENDATION

This item will appear for City Council vote on the October 10, 2023 Public Hearing agenda. Approval of the CUP to allow the use of existing structures at 333, 335, and 337 College Street as office uses associated with the University of Lynchburg in an R-2, Low-Medium Density Residential district.

SUMMARY

The University of Lynchburg is petitioning for a CUP at 333, 335, & 337 College Street to allow the use of existing structures as office uses associated with the University in an R-2, Low-Medium Density Residential district. College and university uses are permitted in this zoning district upon approval of a CUP by City Council.

The Comprehensive Plan 2013-2030 recommends a Low-Density Residential use for the subject properties. Public and private institutional uses compatible in scale with single-family homes may be included in these areas. The properties have been used for student housing since 1989.
