

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF OCONEE COUNTY, GEORGIA CONCERNING THE REDUCTION OF THE AD VALOREM MILLAGE RATE UPON THE PASSAGE OF A ONE PERCENT TRANSPORTATION SALES AND USE TAX AS AUTHORIZED BY ARTICLE 5A OF CHAPTER 8 OF TITLE 48 OF THE OFFICIAL CODE OF GEORGIA ANNOTATED

WHEREAS, Section 48-8-260 *et seq.* of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, as amended, authorizes the imposition of a one percent transportation sales and use tax, the proceeds of which shall be used only for transportation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Oconee County Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the County that a one percent transportation sales and use tax be imposed in Oconee County to raise an estimated amount of \$71,000,000.00 for the purposes of funding transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Oconee County Board of Elections and Registration is calling for a vote on such tax; and

WHEREAS, the passage of such tax will allow for the reduction of that portion of ad valorem taxes which fund transportation projects:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Oconee County, and it is hereby resolved by authority of the same as follows:

The Board of Commissioners resolves to reduce the Ad Valorem Millage rate by one mill beginning with the 2023 tax year upon the passage of the one percent transportation sales and use tax, to be continued for the duration of such tax.
