EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This item is to award a trade contractor agreement with Jalisco International, Inc for the Lemon Gulch Trail Improvements (CIP22-035).

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Town publicly opened competitive bids on September 12, 2023, for the Lemon Gulch Trail Improvements (CIP22-035). This project will connect the Lemon Gulch Trail to the Cherry Creek Regional Trail at Stroh Soccer Park. Included with the improvements will be approximately 2,700 linear feet of trail, a 2,000 square yard sculpted concrete drop structure, earthwork, rip-rap, erosion control, and additional trail related improvements.

Three (3) contractors bid on the project, with Jalisco International, Inc. being the lowest responsible bidder. The contractor successfully completed the Mainstreet North Sidewalk Improvements this year as well as the resurfacing of Bradbury Ranch Drive and other roadways. Therefore, Town staff recommends moving forward with the contract award. The bids were as follows:

1. Jalisco International, Inc	\$2,489,041.00
2. Noraa Concrete Construction Corporation	\$3,183,148.30
3. Concrete Express, Inc	\$3,323,500.80
Engineer's Estimate	\$1,998,103.00

Funding for this project's construction has been appropriated within the Parks and Recreation fund (203-4520).
