RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONTRACT AWARD TO GARRETT CONSULTING, INC., TO PERFORM PHASE II OF THE VETERAN’S PARK PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER AND THE CITY ATTORNEY TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT FOR PHASE II; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, City of Sandy Springs (“City”) has identified the need to design and construct a Veterans Memorial Park (“Project”) in the City; and

WHEREAS, in 2019, the Mayor and City Council authorized City management to move forward with a plan to develop the Project in the triangular shaped lot between Mt. Vernon Highway and Johnson Ferry Road directly across from the City Springs development; and

WHEREAS, Phase I of the Project is nearing completing and there is now a need to identify a qualified contractor to perform Phase II of the Project, to include demolition, hazardous material remediation and landscaping services to prepare the site for construction of the Veterans Memorial Park; and

WHEREAS, to further the Project, the City issued its Invitation to Bid 22-041 (“ITB”) on February 16, 2022; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2022, the City received three (3) bids in response to the ITB, including a bid from Garrett Consulting, Inc., in the amount of \$718,338.00, which was the lowest bid received; and

WHEREAS, following administrative review of the bids and subsequent reference checks, staff recommends contract award in the amount of \$718,338.00 be made to Garrett Consulting, Inc. as the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder to perform Phase II of the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY SPRINGS, GEORGIA:

1. That contract award for Phase II of the Project be made to Garrett Consulting, Inc.
2. That the City Manager and City Attorney are authorized to negotiate a contract in the amount of \$718,338.00 with Garrett Consulting, Inc. to perform Phase II of the Project.
3. That the City Manager is authorized to execute the negotiated contract with Garrett Consulting, Inc.
4. That the City Manager and appropriate City staff are hereby authorized to take such actions as may be deemed necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
