

Emergency Special **ORDINANCE NO.**

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE BUDGET TO TRANSFER FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$10,500.00 FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND TO BE USED FOR PROFESSIONAL GRANT WRITING SERVICES FOR STATE OF MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT GRANTS.

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Economic Development is administering the state of Missouri's allocation of American Rescue Plan Act Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City, in conjunction with Mosaic Life Care, Buchanan County, St. Joseph Chamber of Commerce, and Buchanan County Convention and Visitors Bureau desires to prepare grant applications for "Industrial Site Development" grant funds for Easttown Business Park, "Local Tourism Asset Development" grant funds for continued improvements to the Civic Arena, and "Entertainment Industry" grant funds for Missouri Theater improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City's portion of the grant writing services is \$10,500.00 (of a total \$33,000 cost).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. JOSEPH, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the General Fund budget and the American Rescue Plan Act Fund budget be, and hereby are, amended for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 as follows:
