A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE FY2023 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN (ARPA) STATE - LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS (SLFRF) EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE PROVIDERS GRANT (EMSPG) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,000 TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE ACTIVITIES.

- WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Public Safety has been delegated authority by the U.S. Department of the Treasury to award up to \$20,000 in grant funding opportunities for local law enforcement, fire service, and EMS agencies; and
- WHEREAS, the City has received \$38,704,807 from the U.S. Department of Treasury in conjunction with the American Rescue Plan Act and has agreed to comply with various terms and conditions associated with receipt of ARPA funds; and
- WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Public Safety will impose a local 50% match and ARPA grant funds of \$20,000 may be utilized for a total grant amount of \$40,000; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City of St. Joseph Fire Department will provide all necessary paperwork to the Missouri Department of Public Safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. JOSEPH, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1.** That the City Manager or his designee, on behalf of the City, be, and hereby is, authorized to execute and file a grant application with the Missouri Department of Public Safety for the Emergency Medical Service Providers Grant (EMSPG) in the amount of \$20,000 for emergency medical service activities, a copy of which will be filed in the City Clerk's office simultaneous with its submission to the Missouri Department of Public Safety, and is incorporated herein by reference.
- **SECTION 2.** That the City Manager or his designee be, and hereby is, authorized to execute and file with said application any related documents the Missouri Department of Public Safety may require before awarding this grant.
- **SECTION 3.** That the City Manager, or his designee, be and hereby is, authorized to furnish such additional information as the Missouri Department of Public Safety may require in connection with the application for the program of projects and budget.
