AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND SUBMITTAL OF A MISSOURI HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION (MHTC) PUBLIC TRANSIT OPERATING ASSISTANCE GRANT AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$127,243.00 AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE MASS TRANSIT FUND BUDGET TO BUDGET THE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM MHTC AND TO APPROPRIATE THE ADDITIONAL MATCHING FUNDS NEEDED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$108,243.00 FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$254,486.00.

WHEREAS, the Missouri State Legislature supports public transportation operations by appropriating State General Revenue Funds for such use; and

WHEREAS, the funds made available to subsidize the cost of operations for public transportation services are needed; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission (MHTC) is the body responsible for channeling said funds to the local transportation provider for public transportation operational assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Mass Transit Fund budget contains a portion of the City's matching funds in the amount of \$19,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. JOSEPH, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Public Transit Operating Assistance Grant Agreement by and between the City of St. Joseph, Missouri and the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission (MHTC) for the amount of \$127,243.00 be, and hereby is, approved and that a true and accurate copy of said Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as though fully set out herein.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager, or his designee be, and hereby is, authorized to execute the Agreement with the MHTC in substantially the form as that attached hereto, by and on behalf of the City of St. Joseph, Missouri and is further authorized to sign all necessary documents, amendments, and addenda thereto which may subsequently be required to effectuate the purpose and intent of the Agreement.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager be, and hereby is, authorized to provide additional information as requested by the MHTC to successfully obtain funding authorized by the Agreement.

SECTION 4. That the Mass Transit Fund budget be, and hereby is, amended for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 as follows:

warrant when directed to do so by the Director of Public Works and Transportation.

SECTION 6. That this ordinance shall become effective upon date of passage.
