AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY TAX FUND BUDGET TO RECEIVE FUNDS FROM THE BUCHANAN COUNTY SHERIFF’S OFFICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,397.50 FOR RENEWAL OF THE SHARED ELECTRONIC CRIMES SOFTWARE AND AUTHORIZING RENEWAL OF AN AGREEMENT FOR SAID SOFTWARE.

WHEREAS, Special Ordinance 10086 approved the electronic crimes software purchase shared by the City of St. Joseph, Police Department and the Buchanan County Sheriff’s office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. JOSEPH, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Public Safety Tax Fund for Fiscal Year 2022/2023 be, and hereby is, amended as follows:

To recognize money received from the Buchanan County Sheriff’s office for the renewal of electronic crimes software for the Police Department.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager be, and hereby is, authorized to renew the electronic crimes software for a total amount of \$30,795.00 with equal shared costs between the City of St. Joseph, Missouri and the Buchanan County Sheriff’s office.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager or his designee be, and hereby is, authorized to sign all necessary documents that may subsequently be required to effectuate this renewal.

SECTION 4. That the Finance Director be, and hereby is, authorized to record the budget amendment in the financial records of the City and to charge the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Public Safety Tax Fund, Police Department Program budget, Account Number 2295-1473 (M & R Software) when directed to do so by the Interim Police Chief.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage.
