

Is the use better accommodated in Northam than other City parks?	6
Does use address inquiries received since the Comprehensive Plan was finalized?	
Is there a reasonable maintenance and operation impact?	2
Is the use consistent with national benchmarking?	2

Available Scoring Weight (50) x Amenity Evaluation (2) = 100 Possible Points



























### Design and Construction Schedule

- Notice to Proceed January 8, 2024
- Building Demolition Winter 2024
- Tennis Court Demolition August 2024
- Project Complete Winter 2025

### Bid Comparison (2022 to 2023)

August 2022 Low Base Bid = \$2,580,000 Average Base Bid = \$2,839,864

- 2,400 SF Building
- 3 Clay Tennis Courts
- 170 SF of Asphalt Path

October 2023 Low Base Bid = \$2,467,000 Average Base Bid = \$2,722,574

- 2,400 SF Building
- 8 Clay Tennis Courts
- 19,350 SF of Asphalt Path

#### **Cost Savings Items**

- Two Building Combined into One
- No Locker Rooms / Kitchen
- Outdoor Patio Space Reduced
- No Modifications to Court Lighting
- Waterline installed with West Field Renovation
- Preferable Construction Schedule



#### Staff Recommendations

- Base Bid and Alternates 1-5 fit within the Project Budget
  - Nine Clay Tennis Courts
  - Six Asphalt Pickleball Courts
  - Three Shade Structures
- Recommend adding underground irrigation via council approved change order
- Total Cost of \$3,780,443 (Including 10% Contingency) \$3.9M Budget



### **Project Scope**

- •9 clay tennis courts with below grade irrigation
- •6 asphalt pickleball courts
- •3 year round restrooms
- Storage for athletics (shed will be removed)
- Enhanced connection between Tremont Elementary and Park
- •Expanded buffer between Tremont Pool and the Tennis Complex
- Improved park loop path
- •8 additional shade trees
- •3 shelters provided in key locations
