

## Potential Board Motions for R277-726

R277-726 has been through the Administrative Rulemaking Process described in [Title 63G, Chapter 3, Part 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act](#) and [R15-4, Administrative Rulemaking Procedures](#). Staff can file a notice of effective date for R277-726 with the Office of Administrative Rules (OAR) as early as Thursday, January 7, 2021.

### Options:

- 1) Allow the rule to take effect.
- 2) Hold the rule.
- 3) Amend the rule and refile it with OAR.
- 4) Refer the rule back to committee for further review and consideration.

### Optional Motions:

- 1) Motion to direct staff to file a notice of effective date for R277-726 with the Office of Administrative Rules.
- 2) Motion to direct staff not to file a notice of effective date for R277-726 with the Office of Administrative Rules.
- 3) Motion to adopt an amended version of R277-726 and direct staff to file the amended version of R277-726 with the Office of Administrative Rules.
- 4) Motion to send R277-726 back to a Board Committee for further review and consideration.
