New Information and Recommendation:

During the regular meeting held on April 17, 2023 the City Commission reviewed bids and awarded contract to All Finish Concrete. The contract documents were prepared and delivered to the City Attorney's office for review. After their compliance review, the attached Resolution was prepared for the City Commission's review and approval.

<u>Staff Recommendation</u>: Authorize Notice to Proceed; and Adopt Resolution Approving Contract and Contractor's Bond

Background and Project Summary:

The project will pave the existing gravel road into an urban section concrete roadway which will include the installation of storm sewer. This will accommodate increased activity at the Stockyards site and businesses adjacent to this roadway as well as reduce dust in the area.

Policy Analysis:

This project will improve the accessibility of the Stockyards site by creating a concrete roadway, replacing the existing gravel road. This will be designed by a consultant and bid following city and state procedures.

Financial Analysis:

This project is proposed to be funded exclusively through special assessments to the adjacent properties. Given the favorable bid prices received on the project it is recommended that Alternate A is awarded as well.
